On the Establishment of the Jury Commission and Approval of the Protocol for the Selection of Jury Members for the International Film Festival "Follow Your Heart"

Based on the Regulations of the International Film Festival "Follow Your Heart," approved by the Organizer on January 1, 2022, and in alignment with the festival's mission to promote talented filmmakers whose works cultivate profound emotional resonance with global audiences, the Organizing Committee of the International Film Festival "Follow Your Heart" HAS DECIDED:

- 1. To establish a Jury Commission to conduct the open competitive selection of films at the International Film Festival "Follow Your Heart," (which will take place on November 19, 2022, located at 19226 W Dixie Hwy, Miami, FL 33180, USA), according to the Appendix. This includes provisions for designated jury members to participate in evaluations online where necessary due to geographic, scheduling, or other constraints, ensuring equivalent participation through secure, copyright-compliant platforms. All online evaluations are subject to the same criteria, confidentiality obligations, and audit requirements as in-person participation.
- 2. To approve the *Protocol for the Selection and Work of Jury Members* dated November 1, 2022 No. 011, for conducting the open competitive selection of films at the International Film Festival "Follow Your Heart" (attached), which incorporates detailed procedures for jury selection, evaluation, voting, online participation, and assignment of award categories to jury members based on expertise, as documented in the Appendix.

Oxana Nechaeva (In-person) – Director, Screenwriter, and Producer with more than 15 years of professional experience in the film industry. Holds a degree from the Ostankino Television School (2008), a specialist diploma in Film and Television Directing from the Moscow Institute of Television and Radio Broadcasting (2016), and advanced training from the Alexander Mitta Film School (2021). Her works include the Oscar-nominated documentary "Konstantin Serebrennikov: The Main Victory" (2016) and award-winning short films "American" (2021) and "Daughter" (2021). Recipient of international awards including Gothamite Monthly Film Awards (USA), Cannes Shorts (France), and Gangtok International Film Festival (India). Assigned Nominations: Best Film, Special Jury Prize, Best Short Drama, Best Short Thriller, Best Short Comedy, Best Super Short Film, Best Animation, Best Student Film, Best Young Director (under 21), Best Soundtrack, Special Nominations.
